Graduate students and postdoctoral fellows affiliated with the Graduate School of Biostudies.

15th December, 2022 - **11th January, 2023**
- Confirmation of participation announcement: 1st February, 2023
- Coaching session (for oral presenters): February 2023 (time and venue will be arranged between confirmed speakers and faculty)

5. Procedures

Participants are required to register for the event and upload their abstract onto the designated Google form which can be found on the website. Please make sure to follow the template when preparing for the abstract submission.

Abstract submission deadline: 11th January 2023

*Note

Participants can choose to make oral or poster presentation (or both) in the registration form. However, the final assignment will be decided by the ISS committee, based on the preference of applicants and available time for each session. Presentation and poster assignments can be found on the 19th ISS Schedule Book, which will be sent to the participants at a later time.

7. Evaluation and Award

Two outstanding oral presenters will receive an award based on the evaluation of faculty judges.

One best poster presenter and two runners-up will be awarded by means of votes.

Number and amount of awards are subject to change, according to the number of participants.

Award:

Best oral presentation: 10,000 yen cash prize

Best poster presentation: 10,000 yen cash prize

Runners-up: 5000 yen cash prize
